## QuickIT™

Basic "No Knot" attachment method

- Thread the cord through one of the holes and under the QuickIT™ body.
- Pass the cord back under itself, as show in the picture.
- 3. Pull the free (short) end tight.

You could also use a double figure 8 knot, double overhand knot etc.




Most common use (tent, tarp, canopy lines, etc.)

- Once the cord is secured to one of the holes, wrap the free end of the cord around an anchor point like a tent peg, tree, bumper, etc.
- Pass the cord through the center slot of the QuickIT™ and wrap it around the opposite side and then back through the slot.
- Pull the cord tight.

With tension off the cord, you'll be able to adjust the **QuickIT™** position. Once tension is reapplied, the **QuickIT™** will hold securely once again.

The **QuickIT™** is great for tents, tarps, backpacks, clotheslines, flags, banners, emergency preparedness and more!
